<p><b>If you ever had Tuberculosis or a positive skin test for TB you will always have a positive TB skin test even if you have completed treatment.</b></p> <p><b>You should never get another PPD skin test.</b></p> <p><b>Repeat testing can cause a large, painful reaction at the injection site.</b></p> <p><b>You will need a different assessment process to be a Volunteer.</b></p>
