Recent Projects

College-Career Education Programs: G&A worked with the Sacramento County Office of Education (SCOE) to successfully craft the Capital Region Academies for the Next Economy (*CRANE*) Consortium pilot grant, serving 70 high schools and 197,000 students in a linked learning initiative.
