

LitLab Parent Workshops

LitLab is able to provide the following parent workshops for Family Reading Celebrations. These have generally been about an hour and a half but can be modified for an hour.

- **First Teachers** The importance daily read aloud, talking, playing, singing for children's brain development. Finding opportunities to increase daily reading.
- **Word Wealth** Bridging the Word Gap through oral language development, games and daily activities. The value of back and forth talk instead of one-way communication.
- **Making Math Connections** Building early math skills through daily interactions and fun games at home.
- Social Emotional Learning- Putting words to emotions to promote self-awareness and emotional literacy. Understanding, addressing and reframing challenging behavior. Building empathy.
- **Spotlight 1- School Experiences** Reflect on school experiences and identify goals to create a community of learning. Practice read aloud tips. Demonstrate and enroll in 'Chispa' text messaging program for weekly text and video messages.
- **Spotlight 2-Ready for Summer (for late Spring)**-Reflect on school year goals & discuss their child's characteristics. Practice Activities: Praising the process & Exploring summer opportunities.
